# KS3 Takeaway Homework

Produce a sport word search for primary school children

Create an acronym of Key Terms

Identify the key terms we have used and write a dictionary of terms

Produce a topic sheet on a successful athlete in the sport you are covering

Create an information sheet for someone who has never played the sport you are doing in PE, you must include key skills/techniques/rules for playing this sport

Design a 1 hour PE lesson that you could deliver to primary school children.

Write 5 challenging questions about today's lesson to quiz a class mate

Attend an after-school sports club for 1 ½ term

Create a comic strip to explain a new topic/skill we have learned

Make a video explaining the benefits of keeping fit and healthy through sport

Design a warm up that you could deliver for a sport you are doing at the minute

Pick a new skill you have learned, record yourself performing the skill giving a step by step instructions of how to perform the skill using the correct technique

Make a word cloud about warming up effectively

Write a poem/rap about how to play a certain sport you have learned.

Find a YouTube video that could be used in a lesson as a good example of a skill/technique you can use in a lesson

Attend an after-school sports club for 1 term, keep a diary of each session you go to

Write a diary entry about one of your performances in PE; explain your strengths and weaknesses

Create a TV advert about how to be a gold medal performer in a sport you have been learning. Give examples of how to perform two skills using the correct technique.

Create a poster summarising the topic we have been doing

Create a set of flash cards explaining the skills you have learned

Watch a sporting fixture on TV or the internet and create a 1 page report on the event/results

Create a newspaper article on the topic we have been studying

Create a fact sheet on the benefits of PE in school. Do you think the hours of PE should be increased? Give reasons why.

Write a formal letter to Mrs O'Conner informing her of the topic we have just studied. Include information on rules/tactics/skills
