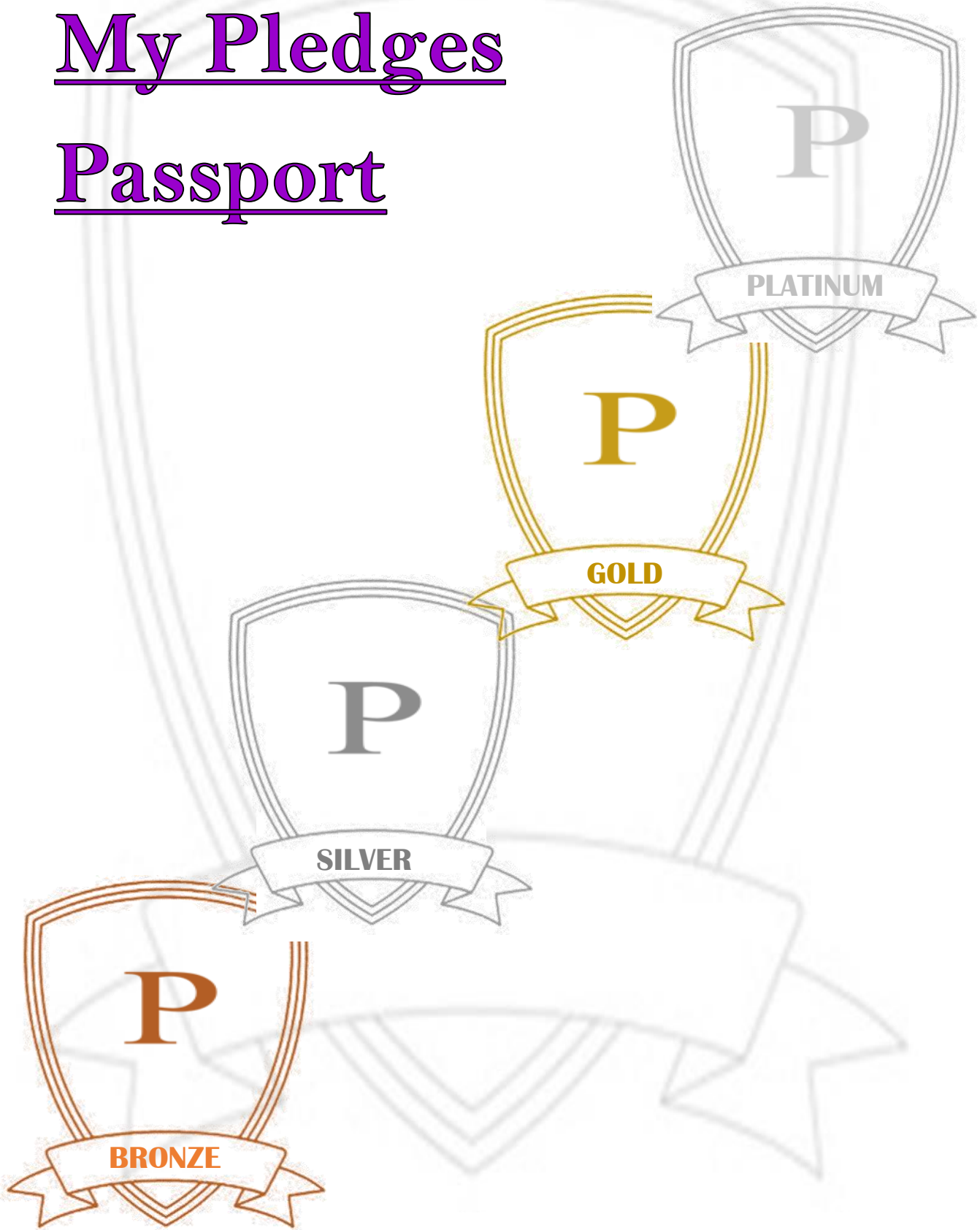

The 10 Pledges:

Pledge 1: Regularly attend an after academy enrichment club.

Pledge 2: Represent the academy in a sporting, cultural or academic event.

Pledge 3: Take part in an outward bound or residential programme.

Pledge 4: Take part in an academy production or event.

Pledge 5: Take part in a formal presentation to an audience.

Pledge 6: Attend a national sporting, cultural or academic event.

Pledge 8: Be actively involved in a community experience or event.

Pledge 9: Help plan, organise or participate in a fund-raising event within the academy.

Why complete pledges?

Completing pledges will lead to you being awarded pledge badges.

Bronze badge - Completion of 4 pledges.

Silver badge - Completion of 6 pledges.

Gold badge - Completion of 8 pledges.

Platinum badge - Completion of 10 pledges.



You must make sure that you get a member of staff, who has seen evidence of you completing your pledge, to sign your pledge passport. Evidence can be in the form of photos, certificates, or other evidence from the event.

When do pledges need to be achieved by?



Key stage 3 graduation:

If you are currently in Year 8, you will need to have achieved at least 2 pledges by the end of the year to graduate into Year 9.

If you are currently in Year 7, you will need to have achieved at least 4 pledges by the end of the year to graduate into Year 9.

Prom:

To receive an invitation to prom, the following pledges must be achieved by the end of Year 11:

- ◆ Current Year 11 students need to achieve 3 pledges to go to their prom.
- ◆ Current Year 10 students need to achieve 5 pledges to go to their prom.
- ◆ Current Year 9 students need to achieve 7 pledges to go to their prom.
- ◆ Current Year 8 & Year 7 students need to achieve all 10 pledges to go to their prom.

 - Year 8 residential**

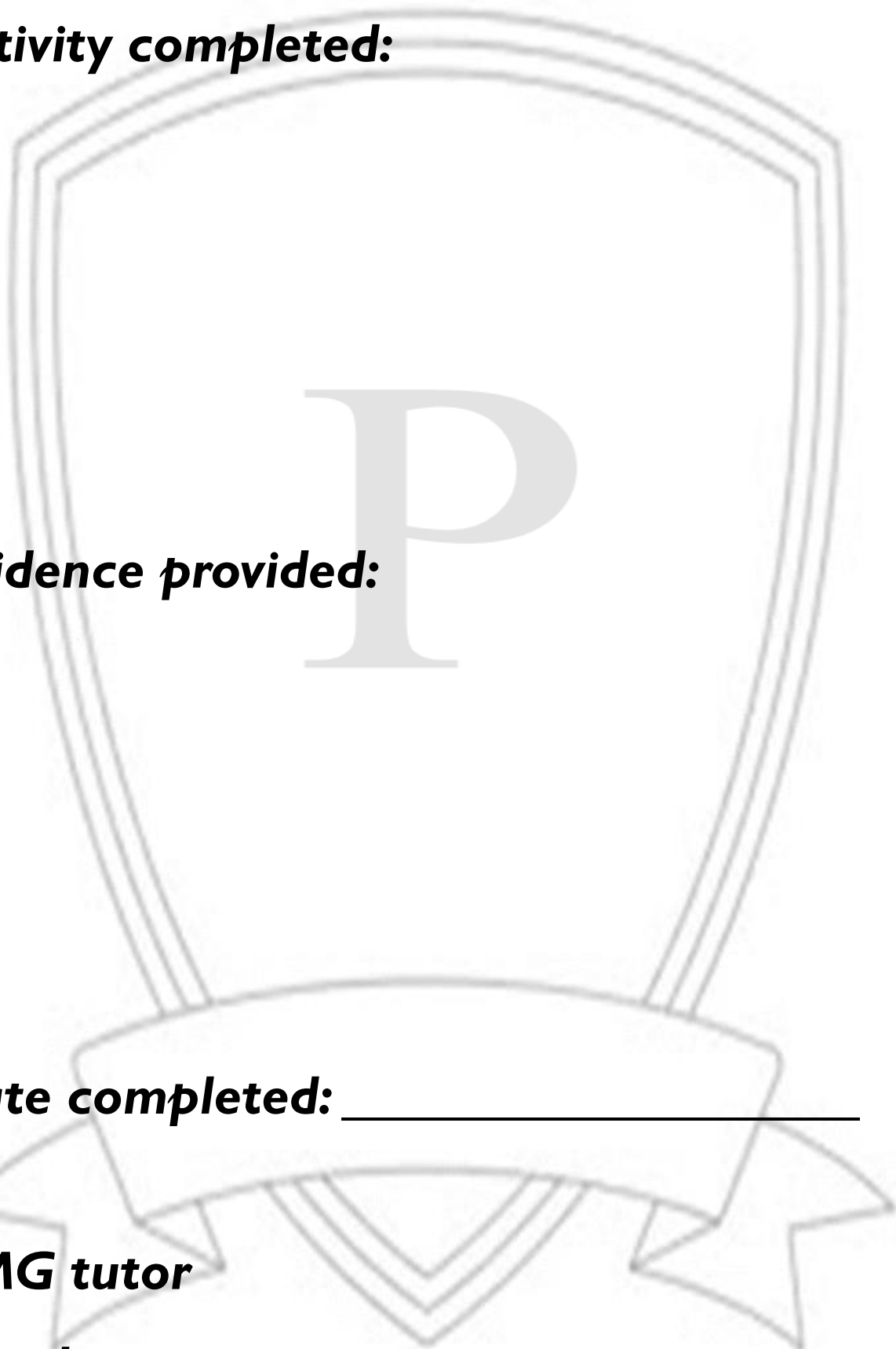
